GENERAL RULES FOR LIVE AND ONLINE COMPETITIONS FOR NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP - SERBIA 2026.

1. **Registration for live competitions closes on March 5, 2026!!!**
2. **Registration for offline competitions closes on February 28, 2026!!! Works must be submitted no later than March 5, 2026!!!**
3. Mobile phones are not allowed for competitors or models during the competition and judging.
4. Competitors may use mobile phones and tablets during the day, but not during the competition. They may use social media during the event. Mobile photos **MUST NOT** be used as inspiration for the competition – you must use your own creativity, imagination, and skill during the day.
5. Minimum age for competitors and models is 18 years, except for the Baby Division, where competitors and models aged 16+ are allowed with a signed parental consent form.
6. Mentors – educators cannot be models for their students during the competition.
7. Tattoos must be covered and should not be visible to the judges. **TATTOOS, RINGS, BRACELETS, WATCHES, AND OTHER MARKS ON THE MODEL'S HANDS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**
8. Only competitors and their models are allowed to enter the competition arena. Translators are allowed but must be registered and authorized by the organizer before the competition. Any other person entering the arena must obtain permission from the organizer or floor judges – this applies to all categories.
9. Competitors will be allowed to set up their tools and products **BEFORE** the start of the competition. All boxes and tool bags (except personal handbags placed under the chair) will be moved to the back wall of the arena. They may not be placed on the worktable. No bags or suitcases may block the passage – it must be clear for floor judges. 5 penalty points will be given if items are left in the wrong place. If the work tables have drawers, products and tools may be stored in them.
10. Tool bags must be kept away from the tables and may not be accessed without permission from the floor judges. All products and tools for the category must be placed on the table. Any products not allowed for that category found on the table will be taken away and placed on a separate table. Competitors will be able to collect them after the competition ends. Repeated violations of this rule may result in a deduction of 10 points.
11. Competitors are not allowed to share products during the competition without the judge's permission.
12. Extension cords may only be used from the outlet provided for the table. They may not be used at another table (unless approved by the onsite electrician and deemed safe).
13. Each table has a workspace and two electrical outlets. The competitor is required to have adapters and extension cords for multiple devices. If a floor judge doubts the safety of an adapter, cord, or electrical device, electricians will be called to inspect it, which may delay the competitor's start time.
14. Desk lamps, UV/LED lamps, hand rests, electric files, and dust collectors are provided by the competitor.
15. Heaters or other local heating devices are not allowed; all local health and safety regulations must be followed.
16. Lighters or matches are prohibited. No open flame is allowed for heating nails, etc. This presents a fire hazard.
17. Each competition will have a briefing scheduled 15 minutes before the start of each category.
18. Competitors and models must be present at the briefing and remain at their tables until the end of the competition category.
19. Once the briefing begins, competitors must not touch their model's nails until the competition starts. If any competitor touches their model's nails after the briefing begins, 5 points will be deducted from the final score.
20. The model's nails will be checked by floor judges during registration to ensure no prior preparation has been done. If it is determined that the model was prepared before registration, the competitor will lose 10 points. Judges will also record any cuts or injuries to nails/skin before the event begins.
21. Tables, jackets, and bags will be inspected. All products on the worktable must be properly labeled. All nail products must be in original packaging with a declaration. The only exceptions are acetone or alcohol that have been poured into pump bottles and must be clearly labeled (e.g., written with a marker on the bottle – acetone, alcohol, etc.). All products used must be legal and cosmetically approved for nail use.
22. Nail forms must be used in the quantity specified in the category criteria. No pre-cutting is allowed. The use of 'form circles' for support is permitted, but no other types of supports not part of the form. If judges suspect any pre-adjustment, the decision will be made by the head judge and one additional judge, resulting in a 20-point deduction for the first offense and disqualification for the second offense in any subsequent category. That means the first offense may occur in one category, and the second in the same or another category.
23. The use of tweezers, clamps, or any tool for pinching the nail is not allowed.
24. The use of metal supports, metal tubes, or any metal bases under the forms is prohibited.
25. The length ratio of the nails should be such that the index and ring fingers are the same length, the thumb and middle finger slightly longer, and the pinky slightly shorter than the index and ring fingers (consistency and proportional length are important).
26. The use of creams, lotions, and oils is allowed.
27. When the designated time expires, competitors must stop working immediately. All competitors must leave the competition arena while all models remain for judging. (This will take time, so competitors are advised to take their bags with them.) Competitors will be allowed to return as soon as possible to clear their tables without interfering with the next competition. Models competing in the next category should raise their hands, go immediately to the floor judge, and be judged first for the just-finished category.
28. Any competitor found still working on their model after the competition has ended will be disqualified by the judge.
29. Competitors are responsible for ensuring that their models understand the judging procedure and that they visit every judge before leaving. (There may be 5–10 judges behind the curtain.)
30. Models must not leave the arena until **ALL** judges have evaluated them. Any model who leaves before being judged will be disqualified.

31. Floor judges have the right to remove, disqualify, or assign penalty points to any competitor seen violating the rules.
32. Since this is an international competition – the organizer understands there are situations beyond our control. This means the organizer will accept a late competitor (already registered and expected) up to **10 minutes after the start** of the competition.
33. New registrations made on the day of the competition will not be accepted, as the computerized system locks one day before the competition. You **MUST** register before the registration deadline.
34. Please download the scoring sheets from the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP website so you can see exactly where the points are awarded.
35. **Team Trophy:** A team must include a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 6 competitors, regardless of their division.
36. Any competitor who does not follow all rules will receive penalty points assigned by the floor judges. For rules that do not specify a deduction, one warning will be given; after that, a 5-point deduction will be applied for the next warning, and disqualification for the third violation.
37. Judges' decisions are final. Score sheets will be sent by email within **15 days** after the event.
38. At the end of the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP event, there will be no individual judge critiques or scoring sheet reviews.
39. You may ask judges for their opinion about your work while the nails are still in the competition area.
40. The rule criteria and scoring forms follow international standards. If you need additional information, download the guidelines at www.nailbeautycongress-championship.com.
41. In the case of tied results, the winner will be determined by the head judge's score.
42. Be kind to your model. It's a long day for them. Make sure they use the restroom before the competition. Ensure your model is fed and well-hydrated throughout the day. Your model may keep track of your time on a wristwatch but must remove it before judging.
43. During the competition, and at the judges' discretion, the model and competitor may use the restroom only if accompanied by a judge or organizer.
44. All reports of rule violations will result in disqualification.
45. The Nail Beauty Championship team is not responsible for any competitor or model who does not follow or understand the rules.

47. **NOTE TO EVERYONE:**
The Nail Beauty Championship team welcomes and encourages competitors to monitor the competitions. Please inform the team if you have previously seen any artwork shown at another competition anywhere in the world. You must be able to prove it with evidence. The same applies to any rule violations of the Nail Beauty Championship witnessed on site. Please inform one of the floor judges immediately.
48. *The work in the offline POSTER category must be sent by email before the deadline, clearly stating that the work is submitted for competition entry. The email must include the following information: category, division, competitor's full name, city and country of residence, and full postal address. If you win a medal or trophy and are unable to attend the ceremony, we will send it to the provided address. Please send it to: info@nailbeautycongress-championship.com*
49. *The work in the offline TIP BOX and ONE NAIL IN FOCUS categories must be sent by email before the deadline, clearly stating that the work is submitted for competition entry. The email must include the following information: category, division, competitor's full name, city and country of residence, and full postal address. If you win a medal or trophy and are unable to attend the ceremony, we will send it to the provided address. Please send it to: info@nailbeautycongress-championship.com.*

DIVISIONS, TEAM TROPHY AND WINNER OF THE WINNER

DIVISIONS

BABY DIVISION – Students from schools and beginners with a maximum of 1 year of experience. With signed parental consent, competitors and models may be 16+ years old.

DIVISION 1 – Beginners (non-educators)

Students and professional nail technicians who have never participated in any nail competition anywhere in the world. (NO educators/trainers are allowed in this category.)

Nail Beauty Championship will accept registration in Division 1 if you have not entered more than 2 national nail competitions in the 12 months prior to Nail Beauty Championship.

DIVISION 2 – Juniors (beginner level educators)

Students and professional nail technicians who have competed but have never won a nail competition anywhere in the world or have placed up to 2nd position. All educators **MUST** use this as their starting level unless they compete in the Master – Division 3.

DIVISION 3 – Masters

Any competitor who has won a world title, a first place at any nail competition, or is ranked as a top competitor.

TEAM TROPHY

What counts as a team?

A team consists of 3 to 6 people from the same or different divisions. Each competitor must register and select as well as fill in the team name and the names of other team members (only for registrations at the Nail Beauty Championship). There is only one winning team.

Included: Flat Art, Mix Media, Pink & White, Salon Almond, Stiletto Nails, One Nail in Focus.

► **NOT INCLUDED** – everything except the categories listed above.

WINNER OF THE WINNER

Included: Pink & White, Salon Almond, Stiletto Nails, 5 Forms, Flat Art, Mix Media, One Nail in Focus. Competitors must participate in 4 or more categories.

There is one winner. The 4 highest scores from all registered categories will be added together.

► **NOT INCLUDED** – everything except the categories listed above.

CRITERIA AND RULES FOR OFFLINE COMPETITION BY CATEGORIES DURING NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP 2026.

EXTREME NAIL STYLE POSTER – THEME: OPEN

1. TASK AND TIME

1. Not a live competition – the photograph (jpeg file) and text must be sent to the organizer by email before the deadline.
2. One hand - 5 nails – with or without face - minimum length 5 cm.
3. All works must be new for the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP competition and may be used only once in this competition. It must be an original photograph that has not been previously published or displayed publicly or on social media.
4. A written description of no more than 50 words (in Serbian or English) must be attached to the photograph, explaining how the look was achieved. This is required so the judges can assess complexity and understand the process. Please note that points will be deducted if the text is not included.
5. The entire photograph will be judged, not just the nail work. Points will be awarded for the nail work and the overall WOW impression. Style, background, and the theme of the photograph will also be evaluated.
6. The longer and more demanding the form, the more points you will get.
7. Think of a nail magazine cover when creating this poster.
8. The image must be in color. Black-and-white and sepia photographs are not allowed.
9. All designs must be original and must not have been shown in previous competitions or photographs.
10. Send the poster and description to info@nailbeautycongress-championship.com from your personal email.

2. MODEL

1. With or without face.

3. ALLOWED

1. You choose the nail creation technique yourself, but the nails must be longer than 5 cm from the cuticle to the free edge.
2. The use of acrylic paints, gel paints, gel polishes, paint colors, glossy or matte top coat is allowed.
3. Only 1 photograph is required.
4. Post-production of the poster is allowed, but not on the nails themselves or in the cuticle area.
5. The finish on the nails can be in any medium. This is an opportunity to “go wild” with nails and imagination, but keep your style.
6. A maximum of ONE work per competitor is allowed in this category.

4. NOT ALLOWED

1. All works must be new for the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP and may be entered only once in this competition. It must be an original photograph that has not been previously published or displayed publicly. Reused work from other competitions is not allowed.
2. The work must not be published on social media or participate in any competition before the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP, nor be published in any magazine before the competition.
3. Black-and-white images are not allowed.
4. Works that have been modified from other competitions are not allowed.

5. TIP

Read the score sheet. Review the point distribution. See where you will get the most points and where you will get the least. This will help you with timing and focus. Knowing where you can gain points and where you can unnecessarily lose them is useful.

6.E MAIL DOCUMENT

One photo without light reflection of one hand. (Minimum photo size 2MB / maximum 10MB.) Write a summary of up to 50 words in Serbian or English with your photo detailing how the look was achieved and send it in Word or PDF format. This is for the judges to assess the complexity and understand the journey to the complete look. Send everything to info@nailbeautycongress-championship.com before the deadline. Email subject – Submission of work for the competition, in the email body please write your first and last name, the category and division you are registered in, the address and country you are from, and attach to the email your work and the text accompanying the work you are sending.

7. IMPORTANT, PAY ATTENTION

- The score sheet will be sent by email within two weeks after the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP event.
- The results will be announced during the ceremony at the competition event and via social media and the website within 2 weeks after Nail Beauty Championship Serbia.
- At the end of the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP event, there will be no individual judge critiques about the nails or the score sheets.
- You may ask the judges for their opinion about your work while the nails are still in the competition.
- The rule criteria and score sheets are based on international standards. If you need additional information, download the guidelines at www.beautycongress-championship.com

POSTER - SALON MANICURE

1. TASK AND TIME

1. Not a live competition – the photograph (jpeg file) and text must be sent to the organizer before the deadline.
2. The entire image will be judged, not just the nail work. Points will be awarded for the final manicure look and the overall WOW factor. Style, background, and the theme of the image will also be evaluated. Think of a magazine cover when creating this poster.
3. A written description of no more than 50 words (in Serbian or English) must be attached to the photograph, explaining how the look was achieved. This is necessary for the judges to assess complexity and understand the process. Please note that points will be deducted if the text is not included.
4. One or two hands, short, square, oval, or almond elegant nails should be shown in one color or in the French manicure style. French manicure can be in color, a combination of colors, or natural. Nail art is not allowed.
5. NOTE: Are the nails clearly visible? Points will be lost if the judges cannot clearly see the nails in order to assess the quality of the final manicure.
6. All works must be new for the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP competition and may be used only once in this competition. It must be an original photograph that has not been previously published or displayed publicly or on social media.
7. The image must be in color. Black-and-white and sephia photographs are not allowed.
8. All designs must be original and must not have been shown in previous competitions or photographs.
9. Send the poster and description to email info@nailbeautycongress-championship.com from your personal email.

2. MODEL

1. Without face. Only a photograph of one or both hands.
2. The background can be of your choice, but the nails must be in the foreground.

3. ALLOWED

1. You choose the nail creation technique yourself, but the nails must not be longer than 2 cm from the cuticle to the free edge.
2. The final layer on the nails can be in the form of nail polish or gel polish.
3. Only 1 photograph is required.
4. Post-production of the poster is allowed, but not on the nails themselves or in the cuticle area.
5. A maximum of ONE work per competitor is allowed in this category.

4. NOT ALLOWED

1. All works must be new for the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP and may be entered only once in this competition. It must be an original photograph that has not been previously published or displayed publicly. Reused work from other competitions is not allowed.
2. The work must not be published on social media or participate in any competition before the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP, nor be published in any magazine before the competition.
3. Black-and-white images are not allowed.
4. Works that have been modified from other competitions are not allowed.
5. Adding decorative elements on nails or 3D designs is not allowed. **Nail art is not allowed.**

5. TIP

Read the score sheet. Review the point distribution. See where you will get the most points and where you will get the least. This will help you with timing and focus. Knowing where you can gain points and where you can unnecessarily lose them is useful.

6. E MAIL DOCUMENT

One photo without light reflection of one hand. (Minimum photo size 2MB / maximum 10MB.) Write a summary of up to 50 words in Serbian or English with your photo detailing how the look was achieved and send it in Word or PDF format. This is for the judges to assess the complexity and understand the journey to the complete look. Send everything to info@nailbeautycongress-championship.com before the deadline. Email subject – Application of work for the competition, in the body of the email please write your first and last name, the category and division you are registered in, the address and the country you are from, and attach to the email your work and the text accompanying the work you are sending.

ONE NAIL IN FOCUS – THEME: OPEN

LONGER THAN 10 CM – SHAPE ONLY ONE NAIL

1. TASK AND TIME

1. Not a live competition – the work must be sent to the organizer before the deadline.
2. This is your opportunity to show the world how creative, imaginative, and skilled you are. Design your original extreme nail shape, sculpt it, and decorate it.
3. It is necessary to create only one nail of any length over 10 cm from the cuticle. This is extreme nail shaping with strong artistic expression.
4. Any nail product with crystals/stones etc. may be used for style and design purposes.
5. **Be creative and create an impressive, newly invented nail shape with design underneath, on the sides – anywhere.**
6. **JUDGES want to see invention, A TRULY NEW NAIL SHAPE. This is the main purpose of this competition. If you create an already known nail form, keep in mind that the technical part will be judged by the rules and criteria of that form, but you are free to invent a completely new shape.**
7. It is necessary to show as much creativity and innovation as possible.
8. This provides an opportunity to showcase beautiful structure and creative skills in design. GO WILD!!!
9. The work and its description should be sent to info@nailbeautycongress-championship.com from your personal email.

2. ALLOWED

1. You choose the nail creation technique yourself, but the nail must be longer than 10 cm from the cuticle to the free edge.
2. The use of acrylic paints, gel paints, gel polishes, paint gels, glossy or matte top coats is allowed.
3. Everything is allowed. The more techniques, skills, and creativity you show, the better.
4. The finish on the nail can be in any medium. This is an opportunity to “go wild” with the nail and your imagination, but keep it stylish.
5. A maximum of ONE work per competitor is allowed in this category.

3. NOT ALLOWED

1. All works must be new for the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP and may be entered only once in this competition. It must be an original photograph that has not been previously published or displayed publicly. Reused work from other competitions is not allowed.
2. The work must not be published on social media or participate in any competition before the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP, nor be published in any magazine before the competition.
3. There are no shape limitations – everything is acceptable.
4. Works that have been modified from other competitions are not allowed.

4. TIP

Read the score sheet. Review the point distribution. See where you will get the most points and where you will get the least. This will help you with timing and focus. Knowing where you can gain points and where you can unnecessarily lose them is useful.

5. E MAIL DOCUMENT

One photo without light reflection from above, from both side and from underneath. (Minimum photo size 2MB / maximum 10MB.) Write a summary of up to 50 words in Serbian or English with your photo detailing how the look was achieved and send it in Word or PDF format. This is for the judges to assess the complexity and understand the journey to the complete look. Send everything to info@nailbeautycongress-championship.com before the deadline. Email subject – Submission of work for the competition, in the email body please write your first and last name, the category and division you are registered in, the address and the country you are from, and attach to the email your work and the text accompanying the work you are sending. This is sent just in case due to the transport of the work you are sending if it gets damaged.

6. IMPORTANT, PAY ATTENTION

- The score sheet will be sent by email within two weeks after the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP event.
- The results will be announced during the ceremony at the competition event and via social media and the website within 2 weeks after the Nail Beauty Championship Serbia.
- At the end of the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP event, there will be no individual judge critiques about the nails or the score sheets.
- You may ask the judges for their opinion about your work while the nails are still in the competition.
- The rule criteria and score sheets are based on international standards.

TIP BOXMIX MEDIA – THEME: SPRING MAGIC

- 10 artificial nails –

1. TASK AND TIME

1. Not a live competition – the work and text must be sent to the organizer before the deadline.
2. Competitors must use 3 of the following 5 nail art materials and techniques: airbrushing, decorations (rhinestones, tapes, etc.), acrylic, gel, hand painting, one stroke. Failure to use 3 of the listed materials and techniques will result in a deduction of 10 points.
3. For design consistency, please follow the given theme.
4. The work must not have been seen in any competition in the world.
5. The entire work must be ORIGINAL and must not be reused from previous competitions, copied from masterclasses, or be the work of another technician. It must be completely original.
6. A written description of no more than 50 words (in Serbian or English) must be attached to the work, explaining how the look was achieved, as well as the types of nail art materials and techniques used. This is necessary for the judges to assess the complexity and understand the process. Please note that points will be deducted if the text is not included.
7. This competition follows the “show & describe” format. The nails are designed on artificial nails of different sizes and placed together. 5 different sizes of artificial nails.
8. The three-dimensional part on the nails must not exceed 5 mm in height from the surface of the nail. Decorations higher than this may not be displayed or considered, and if too large, may be disqualified. This is at the judges’ discretion. The works are measured by the judges. Any decoration on the nails, whether attached or not, must not exceed 5 mm from the nail surface, otherwise 10 points will be deducted.
9. The work and its description should be sent to info@nailbeautycongress-championship.com from your personal email.

2. ALLOWED

1. The use of acrylic paints, gel paints, gel polishes, and paint gels is allowed.
2. Competitors use all artistic painting or one stroke techniques.
3. All materials and techniques used must be applied artistically. It is the competitor’s responsibility to clarify anything that may be questioned before the competition, and the judges’ decisions are final.
4. This is an opportunity to use your imagination, but keep it stylish.
5. A maximum of ONE work per competitor is allowed in this category.

3. NOT ALLOWED

1. All works must be new for the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP and may be used only once. No repeated works from other competitions.
2. The work must not be published on social media, participate in any competition before the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP, or be published in any magazine in advance.
3. DO NOT glue 10 nails together to create one large canvas – there must be a gap between the nails, and at least 5 different sizes of competition tips in a square shape of 10 cm length must be used.
4. Stickers are not allowed.
5. Stamping technique is not allowed.
6. The use of molds is not allowed in this category.
7. No decoration or product may extend more than 5 mm from the original nail surface in any direction; if this happens, 10 points will be deducted.
8. Works that have been modified from other competitions are not allowed.

4. TIP

Read the score sheet. Review the point distribution. See where you will get the most points and where you will get the least. This will help you with timing and focus. Knowing where you can gain points and where you can unnecessarily lose them is useful.

5. E MAIL DOCUMENT

One photo without light reflection from above and from both sides. (Minimum photo size 2MB / maximum 10MB.) Write a summary of up to 50 words in Serbian or English with your photo detailing how the look was achieved and send it in Word or PDF format. This is for the judges to assess the complexity and understand the journey to the complete look. Send everything to info@nailbeautycongress-championship.com before the deadline. Email subject – Submission of work for the competition, in the email body please write your first and last name, the category and division you are registered in, the address and the country you are from, and attach to the email your work and the text accompanying the work you are sending. This is sent just in case due to the transport of the work you are sending if it accidentally gets damaged.

FLAT ART TIP BOX DESIGN - THEME: FAIRYTALE MAGIC

–10 artificial nails –

1.TASK AND TIME

1. Not a live competition – the work and text must be sent to the organizer before the deadline.
2. Only hand painting – no airbrush technique or any nail decorations.
3. This competition is in the format of “art painting.” Nails are designed on nails of different sizes and placed together, but they must not touch.
4. Do not glue 10 nails together to create one large canvas – there must be an OBVIOUS gap between the nails, and 5 different nail sizes must be used.
5. A written description of no more than 50 words (in Serbian or English) must be attached to the work, explaining how the look was achieved, as well as the types of nail art materials and techniques used. This is necessary for the judges to assess complexity and understand the process. Please note that points will be deducted if the text is not included.
6. The work and its description should be sent to info@nailbeautycongress-championship.com from your personal email.;

2.ALLOWED

1. The use of acrylic paints, gel paints, gel polishes, and paint gels is allowed.
2. Competitors use all artistic painting and one stroke techniques.
3. All materials and techniques used must be applied artistically. It is the competitor’s responsibility to clarify anything that may be questioned before the competition, and the judges’ decisions are final.
4. This is an opportunity to use your imagination, but keep it stylish.
5. A maximum of ONE work per competitor is allowed in this category.

3.NOT ALLOWED

1. All works must be new for the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP and may be used only once. No repeated works from other competitions.
2. The work must not be published on social media, participate in any competition before the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP, or be published in any magazine in advance.
3. DO NOT glue 10 nails together to create one large canvas – there must be a gap between the nails, and at least 5 different sizes of competition tips must be used.
4. Stickers are not allowed.
5. The use of the stamping technique is not allowed.
6. The use of molds in this category is not allowed.
7. The use of decorations or acrylic products is not allowed; otherwise, 10 points will be deducted.
8. Any decoration of the tips, whether attached to the tip or not, will be considered a violation and will result in a deduction of 10 points.
9. No works that have been modified from previous competitions are allowed.

4. TIP

Read the score sheet. Review the point distribution. See where you will get the most points and where you will get the least. This will help you with timing and focus. Knowing where you can gain points and where you can unnecessarily lose them is useful.

5. E MAIL DOCUMENT

One photo without light reflection from above and from both sides. (Minimum photo size 2MB / maximum 10MB.) Write a summary of up to 50 words in Serbian or English with your photo detailing how the look was achieved and send it in Word or PDF format. This is for the judges to assess the complexity and understand the journey to the complete look. Send everything to info@nailbeautycongress-championship.com before the deadline. Email subject – Submission of work for the competition, in the email body please write your first and last name, the category and division you are registered in, the address and the country you are from, and attach to the email your work and the text accompanying the work you are sending. This is sent just in case due to the transport of the work you are sending if it accidentally gets damaged.

6.IMPORTANT, PAY ATTENTION

- The score sheet will be sent by email within two weeks after the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP event.
- The results will be announced during the ceremony at the competition event and via social media and the website within 2 weeks after the Nail Beauty Championship Serbia.
- At the end of the NAIL BEAUTY CHAMPIONSHIP event, there will be no individual judge critiques about the nails or the score sheets.
- You may ask the judges for their opinion about your work while the nails are still in the competition.
